The Sabeto mud pool and hot springs are one of Fiji's hidden jewels, and offer a rare opportunity to indulge in a therapeutic, natural, thermal mud spa. The therapeutic mud pool of Sabeto is the ideal remedy for self-cleansing, or naturally beautifying yourself. Locals believe that the sulphur in the hot springs have healing properties. A popular spot for both visitors and locals, the mud pool also offers a great social experience. After absorbing the soothing and healing properties of the mud, wash it off in the natural hot springs and enjoy the rejuvenating feeling after this cleansing procedure.
