## SYDNEY, AUSTRALIA

### THE SYDNEY OPERA HOUSE: AN ICON OF THE CITY

Since its inauguration in 1973, the Sydney Opera House has caught the eye of the world thanks to its bold design. Dreamt up by Danish architect Jørn Utzon, this monumental building has quickly become an iconic symbol of Australia and modern architecture. Its genesis dates back to the 1950s, when the New South Wales government launched an international competition to design a new opera house for Sydney. Of the 255 proposals received, that of Danish architect Jørn Utzon was chosen. Construction began in 1959, but it was not without its problems. Technical challenges, cost overruns and political disputes marred the construction process, even leading to Utzon's resignation in 1966 and the resumption of the project by local architects. In the end, the building cost 102 million Australian dollars: a far cry from the 7 million predicted in 1957, but paid for in full before 1975 by a public lottery.

An architectural masterpiece, the Sydney Opera House is made up of several white hulls in the shape of a sail or shell that seem to float on the water, creating an instantly recognisable silhouette that has become emblematic of the city of Sydney. These concrete shells are covered with more than a million self-cleaning white or beige ceramic tiles made in Sweden. But the Sydney Opera House is first and foremost... an opera house, and the building is home to several world-renowned theatres and is the headquarters of the Australian Opera House, the Sydney Theatre Company and the Sydney Symphony Orchestra. When it was inaugurated in the presence of Queen Elizabeth II on 20 October 1973, Beethoven's Ninth Symphony was played, but this work was far from the first to be heard within its walls: during construction, from 1960 onwards, musical lunch breaks were scheduled for the workers.

Over the decades, the Sydney Opera House has become much more than just a place of entertainment. Today, it is a symbol of Australian identity, a cultural landmark and an economic driver for the region, attracting millions of visitors every year from all over the world to admire the work.

Opened in 1898, glorious stained glass windows and splendid architecture endure throughout the building and an original 19th century staircase sits alongside a mighty centre dome, consisting of an inner glass dome and an exterior copper-sheathed dome.
