## SAN FRANCISCO, CALIFORNIA

### ICONIC BRIDGE, HISTORIC CABLE CARS, AND BEAUTIFUL VICTORIAN ARCHITECTURE

San Francisco: home of the Golden Gate Bridge. A marvel of engineering, it towers over the waters of the Golde Gate with its 2737m (2993 yards) of suspended steel and concrete. This is the Golden Gate Bridge, one of the greatest symbols of the United States of America and classified as one of the 7 Wonders of the Modern World.

With the prosperity that accompanied the rebuilding of San Francisco after the destructive earthquake of 1906, the city was cramped for space on its peninsula and the idea of a bridge was born to complement the ferries and boats that criss-crossed the bay at the time. But the Golden Gate, the strait that separates San Francisco from Marin County, is a place where nature is violent and dangerous, with currents of up to 95 km/h (60 mph), violent winds and a persistent sea fog laden with highly corrosive salt. After years of technical work to find a solution to all these constraints, of political work to get such work accepted in an America hit by the economic crisis of 1929 and of fund-raising to finance the 27 million dollars - just over 350 million today - the project was launched in 1933.

The idea was to build two towers in the middle of the bay, resting at a depth of 30 metres. To achieve this, after preparing the seabed with the help of divers, gigantic concrete rings were built several tens of metres deep, so that the bedrock on which the pillars would be built could be dried out. Once the pillars were complete, the 227 metres of pylons were built, pushing back the technical limits known at the time. It took eleven and six months to complete the Marin Tower - the North Tower - and the San Francisco Tower. The first steel cables were stretched in July 1935 and lasted until May 1936, when the first plates could be laid before the traffic lanes were built on top. The final phase of work began in January 1937 with the ornamentation of the bridge. In April 1937, the world's largest bridge was completed, ahead of schedule, and it was inaugurated in May, giving rise to a huge popular celebration in San Francisco. Although the original plan was for the Golden Gate Bridge to be painted yellow and black, the designer opted for International Orange.
