A UNIQUE BLEND OF ARTS, DANCE, MUSIC, RITUALS, AND RELIGIOUS TRADITIONS

Legend has it that Bali, the Island of the Gods, was once one with Java. There lived a great and powerful priest called Siddhi Mantra. He had a brilliant and gifted son, Manik Angkeran, but when he reached adulthood, he became an addicted to cockfighting and gambling. Naturally, he lost all his money and, to continue indulging his vice, began stealing his father's possessions. When Siddhi Mantra realised that his son was stealing from him, he advised him to get away from the world so as not to be tempted again. To no avail...

BALI TOURISM LEVY

The Bali local Government in Indonesia has implemented the Bali Tourism Levy of IDR 150,000 (\$10 USD) to support local infrastructure and maintenance programs to ensure ongoing sustainability of the island. This Levy applies to all foreign tourists who come off the vessel for any means whilst in Bali and is valid until your departure from Indonesia. **Guests are not required to pay the Tourism Levy, Silversea Cruises has arranged to pay the Levy on behalf of all Guests** who will disembark and also go ashore whilst in transit during our stay in Bali.
