



OTARU, JAPAN

FAMOUS FOR ITS GLASS PRODUCTS, MUSIC BOXES, AND ALCOHOL BEVERAGES

Otaru is a small harbor city west of Sapporo. Famous for its many hills and a nearby ski resort the town has been an important trade and herring fishing center since the 1800s. A wide canal that led from the port to the old town's warehouses which were built by foreign shipping and trading companies, has been maintained for touristic purposes. The old stone or brick-built warehouses have been beautifully converted to restaurants and boutiques.

Local artists display their crafts by daytime, while old-fashioned gas lamps illuminate the area with a gentle glow by night, making it a pleasant place to stroll at any time. However, the canal area is undoubtedly at its most photogenic during the Otaru Snow Light Path festival, held each year in February, when the city is decorated with hundreds of enchanting candle-lit snow lanterns.

After you've explored the canal and its surroundings, continue your time-travelling as you take a turn along Sakaimachi Street, a well-preserved traditional merchant street, exploring some of its quirky museums before heading for a well-deserved sushi lunch. The street is lined with impressive western-style buildings constructed in the late 1800s and early 1900s and many of the buildings exteriors have been carefully preserved.

Sakaimachi Street is also home to a handful of interesting museums, like the Museum of Venetian Art, opened by local glass producer Kitaichi. It is dedicated to showcasing the arts of Venice including Venetian glassware, clothing and furniture, as well as a full-scale gondola. Another highlight is the Music Box Museum which is Japan's largest music box shop and an internationally well-known sightseeing attraction in Otaru.

Please note, that due to the Animal/Quarantine regulation in Japan, the following items are **prohibited to carry with you when leaving the ship: Meat / Fruits / Vegetables / Eggs / Dairy products / Nuts / Plants / Seeds**. Thank you for your cooperation.

FACE-TO-FACE INSPECTION IN OTARU, JAPAN

As part of exit formalities from Japan, **ALL GUESTS are subject to mandatory Face to Face Inspection** with Customs, Immigration and Quarantine (CIQ) on May 1st, 2024 prior to our departure from Otaru, Japan. **This inspection will take place ashore between 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.** and should only be completed within the allocated time if you no longer wish to go ashore after your final return to the ship. Guests remaining onboard until departure may proceed for the Inspection at their convenience any time after 1:00 p.m. via the designated route to the Immigration hall inside the Cruise Terminal.

Please note you will not be permitted to go ashore after you have been through the Inspection, therefore please proceed for your Inspection if you will no longer wish to go ashore and within the allocated time. The Ship's staff will be positioned after the Immigration booths to collect your passport, therefore please hand over your passport after you've completed the inspection.

Announcements will be made by PA system indicating when you should proceed ashore, hence please listen carefully to the announcements. We thank you for your cooperation and support in complying with the local requirement.

A GENERAL DRILL FOR THE CREW WILL BE HELD THIS MORNING
