## NAGASAKI, JAPAN

VOLCANOES, BEAUTIFUL OFFSHORE ISLANDS, HISTORIC BUILDINGS & HOT-SPRING SPAS

Utterly devastated in just a few seconds, Nagasaki was the target of the second US atomic bomb, as World War II moved towards its horrifying conclusion. More than 50,000 were killed, and the stories here are harrowing and poignant. The fact that Nagasaki still stands at all, and has embarked on a new mission to promote global peace with a message of hope, is a testament to the people of this extraordinary place.

The scars the city wears will never heal, but the colour, culture and creativity of Nagasaki may surprise you. Of course, the events of August 9th 1945 are unavoidable, and the Atomic Bomb Museum pulls no punches in its rendering of the story. Hear from survivors, known as 'Hibakushas', who speak at the centre, sharing tales of sadness, hope and resilience.

The Memorial Hall is a glass structure of meditation and messages of peace left by visitors from every corner of the world. Nagasaki Peace Park honours the victims, while the Hypocenter Park marks the explosion's epicentre. Suwa Shrine stands just 800 metres away, and you can see the iconic, one-legged torii which was photographed, miraculously still standing amid the sea of devastation.

Look out for the temple's scarred trees, which somehow survived the blast too. Look out over the city, nestled in the undulations of the valley – as you reach the top of Mount Inasa - which actually served to protect and shelter Nagasaki from even more destruction. Up here, you can't help but consider the city's journey - as it spreads out before you. A ropeway or a bus will help you reach this spectacular vantage point, to observe the harbour glittering and glistening peacefully.

#### NAGASAKI KOSHIBYO CONFUCIUS SHRINE

Built in 1893, this is the only Confucian mausoleum constructed by the Chinese outside China. Renovated in 1982 with the support of the Chinese government, the Temple and Cemetery of Confucius in Qufu, Shandong Province, this temple is a unique structure that blends the architectural styles of both Southern and Northern China.



ARIA nominated concert pianist and Universal/Decca/Deutsche Grammophon recording artist Van-Anh Nguyen became the first Australian-Vietnamese in history to enter the US iTunes Classical Charts. Born to Vietnamese refugee musicians and having started piano studies at the tender age of 13 months old, Australian born concert pianist gave her Sydney Opera House debut at age 8.

Her bubbly contagious personality and emotive playing has graced

the stages as a soloist across Australia at venues including the Sydney Opera House, City Recital Hall, the Forbidden City Concert Hall (China), the Shanghai Oriental Arts Centre (China), Segerstrom Performing Arts Center (LA), Herbst Theater (SF). Her ability to perform classically as well as have the stage flair for creative classical-crossover arranging and mash ups has allowed her to perform for such brands as Moet & Chandon, Porsche, Barons de Rothschild, the Patron Secret Society, Fairfax & Roberts, Vicki Lee Gallery, Ferrari to name a few.

Van-Anh currently has 10 albums released on all major digital music outlets with her most recent release on Deutsche Grammophon. Van-Anh has been featured across various publications including L'Officiel Magazine, Elle Magazine Vietnam, Sunday Life, Marie Claire Australia and Harper's Bazaar Magazine as a music icon and she has had her own TV show on Discovery Channel Asia.

Van-Anh is the creator and owner of Perfect Pairings, a concert concept where she pairs music to wine. #### MANDATORY FACE-TO-FACE INSPECTION IN NAGASAKI, JAPAN

As part of exit formalities from Japan, **ALL GUESTS are subject to mandatory Face-to-Face Inspection** with Customs, Immigration and Quarantine (CIQ) on April 25th, 2024 prior to our departure from Nagasaki, Japan. This inspection **will take place ashore between 4:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m.**, during this time Guests who will be onboard will be guided to proceed ashore for their Inspection and those returning after 4:00 p.m. will be directed by Terminal staff to pass through the CIQ Terminal via designated routes to complete their exit formalities.

Please note, you will not be permitted to go ashore after you have been through the Inspection, therefore please proceed for your Inspection if you will no longer wish to go ashore and within the allocated time. Announcements will be made by PA system indicating when you should proceed ashore, hence please listen carefully to the announcements. We thank you for your cooperation and support in complying with the local requirement.
