KANAZAWA, JAPAN

A CASTLE TOWN WITH OVER 400 YEARS OF RICH HISTORY

The capital of the Ishikawa Prefecture, Kanazawa once rivalled Kyoto and Edo (Tokyo) as a town rich in cultural achievements. Kanazawa escaped destruction during World War II and accordingly has been able to preserve many of the old districts in good shape.

The city is famous because of Kenrokuen. Located next to Kanazawa Castle, Kenrokuen is classified as "One of the Three Gardens of Japan". The garden has an artificial pond, and hills and houses are dotted within the 11.4 hectares. It has Japan's oldest fountain using natural water pressure and a tea-house dating back to 1774.

Close by is the Higashi Chaya Gai Geisha District, designated a National Cultural Asset and the biggest of the Geisha districts of Kanazawa. Some of the houses not only retain the original structure, but still are used as Geisha houses. Some of the streets have traditional shops creating a nostalgic atmosphere.

Kanazawa is also known for its lacquer ware, Kutani-style pottery, gold-leaf workmanship and delicately painted silk kimonos.

HIGASHI CHAYA DISTRICT

The name Higashi Chaya-gai literally means "Eastern Teahouse District," because the chaya, or teahouses, were where wealthy customers would be entertained by geisha with traditional music, dancing, and drinking games. The geisha houses in Higashi Chaya have a stunning traditional appearance and the district includes facilities where you can see the interior of a geisha house that was built almost 200 years ago, as well as old buildings which have been refurbished into restaurants, cafes, and souvenir shops.

Please note, that due to the Animal/Quarantine regulation in Japan, the following items are **prohibited to carry with you when leaving the ship: Meat / Fruits / Vegetables / Eggs / Dairy products / Nuts / Plants / Seeds**. Thank you for your cooperation.

FACE-TO-FACE INSPECTION IN KANAZAWA, JAPAN

As part of the entry formalities into Japan, **ALL guests are subject to mandatory Face-to-Face inspection** shortly after our arrival in Kanazawa, Japan. Please note this inspection **includes Temperature screening, Biometrics and Passport scanning with local authorities and will take place ashore in the Cruise Terminal** once authorities are ready to receive you i.e. approximately from 9:00 a.m. onwards. **Please carry your Passport, Immigration Arrival card (one per person) & Custom declaration (One per family) with you for the inspection.** After being processed by all authorities, you are cleared and can proceed ashore carrying your original passport and Suite key card, and these will be the only form of ID you will need to carry with you when going ashore in all Japanese ports.

Also, please note if you wish to return back onboard after the Inspection, then you will not be able to go ashore until all guests have passed through the inspection and authorities have granted full clearance to the ship. *Announcements will be made by PA system indicating when you should proceed to the inspection, hence please listen carefully to the announcements. We thank you for your cooperation and support in complying with the local requirement.*
