Experience the breath-taking panoramic beauty of Vancouver during this captivating, half-day sightseeing excursion to Stanley Park and Grouse Mountain.

See a portion of the park's approximately 1,000 acres (about 404 hectares) of fir, cedar, and hemlock forests, trails, flower gardens, and beaches, all surrounded by a sea wall. A stop is made in the park at a collection of fascinating totems.

Your next destination is Grouse Mountain, one of Vancouver's most beautiful local attractions. Upon arrival, board the Skyride Aerial Tram for an exhilarating ride to the top of this majestic mountain, which towers approximately 4,100 feet (about 1.25 kilometres) in elevation.

A final photo stop is made at Prospect Point for splendid ocean vistas of the Gulf Islands in the distance.

VANCOUVER, CANADA FAMOUS FOR BEING ONE OF THE BEST PLACES IN THE WORLD TO LIVE

Although the area has been inhabited by the Squamish, Musqueam and Tseil-Waututh First Nations for more than 10,000 years, Vancouver is a young city. Its historic heart lies in the trendy Gastown district and its starting point is today marked by the Gastown Steam Clock. It was here that a steamboat captain from Yorshire, Jack Deighton, decided to open the very first saloon in what was still just a group of shacks around the Hastings Mill, which had opened in 1865.

The success of the place attracted people and the town grew up around the bar. The owner's voluble personality soon earned him the name Jack 'Gassy' Deighton. It didn't take long for the little settlement to be named "Gassy's Town" and then, as time went by, Gastown. In 1870, the colonial government made the town official but substituted the name Granville in honour of the Secretary of State of the Colonies at the time, the British Lord Granville. It wasn't until 1886 that the city took on its current name of Vancouver with the arrival of the Canadian Pacific Railway, which expanded the city to include Gastown. Vancouver soon reached its first thousand inhabitants.

But 1886 was also marked by the "Great Fire", which destroyed almost the entire city in no time. The purpose of the man-made fire was to clear a parcel of land for the construction of a railway depot for the Canadian Pacific Railway. But all did not go as planned and the fire, which got out of control, destroyed between 600 and 1000 buildings.

The town was soon rebuilt and prospered rapidly, thanks to its port, railway and geographical location, growing from 1,000 inhabitants to 20,000 in 1900 and 100,000 in 1911. Today, it is the largest city in the region, with a population expected to reach 700,000 by 2021.

As for the historic district of Gastown, which was in ruins and almost destroyed at the end of the 60s, its importance has been recognised, its historic buildings renovated and it was designated a National Historic Site of Canada in 2009. Today, Gastown is a lively and very touristy district.

FACE-TO-FACE INSPECTION - PRE-CLEARANCE INTO UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

A mandatory face-to-face Inspection will take place with US CBP for ALL GUESTS on 23rd May in Vancouver, Canada prior to our departure for San Francisco, USA. During this inspection all guests will be pre-cleared into USA and will not be subject to any other immigration formalities thereafter in San Francisco. This inspection will take place ashore inside the Terminal Facility from approximately 2:30 p.m. onwards, as per CBP requirements all guests who will be on-board at 2:00 p.m. should proceed to the Terminal for Inspection and those ashore will not be able to gain access to the ship until after the start of the Inspection. We will make announcements by PA system indicating when you should proceed ashore, hence please listen carefully to the announcement as we won't have permission from US CBP to commence pre-clearance until we confirm that ALL GUESTS are shore side for the inspection.

After being processed by the US CBP Officer, you are cleared into US and will have to pass by CBP desk for passport control every time you go ashore or return on board. Please note that this inspection is a requirement of law and is compulsory for all guests. The Ship will not receive permission to sail until all guests have passed through the inspection and are accounted for prior to departure.
