Experience the spectacular, colourful, and natural hot springs of Beppu during this scenic, half-day sightseeing excursion. Depart the pier for the short drive to Chinoike Jigoku, one of eight jigokus in Beppu. Next, re-board your coach and head to another hot spring named Umi Jigoku (Sea Hell), due to its amazing, cobalt-blue boiling waters. At Yunosato, see the cloudy-coloured sulphur springs, a mineral renowned for its power to remove sebum and dirt from the skin.

Commitment to peace

History buffs will want to write home Hiroshima. Despite being devastated in 1945, this Japanese city is known to all for its commitment to peace – its ruin on the 6th August 1945 led to the end of the war and today, the Peace Memorial (a UNESCO World Heritage Site), is a constant reminder of the destruction that war brings.

A walk in the leafy boulevards of Peace Memorial Park brings quiet contemplation. The Flames of Peace – set in the park's central feature pond – burn brightly and will continue to do so until all the nuclear bombs the world have been destroyed. There are many other inspiring messages of hope around the city too; the Children's' Peace Monument just north of the park is a homage to little Sadako Sasaki, who was just two in 1945. When she developed leukemia in 1956, she believed that if she folded 1,000 paper cranes – a symbol of longevity and happiness in Japan – she would recover. Sadly, she died before she finished her task but her classmates finished the rest. If you are lucky enough to visit during the unpredictable and short-lived Sakura (cherry blossom) season, then the extraordinary sight of the delicate pink blossom floating across the water to the red gate, means you can consider yourself one of the luckiest people on the planet.

HIROSHIMA PEACE MEMORIAL MUSEUM

Displays of models, charred fragments of clothing, melted ceramic tiles, lunch boxes, watches, and shocking photographs tell Hiroshima's story of death and destruction.

A visit here may be too intense for some (especially children), but to appreciate the horror of the bombing and the hope that made Hiroshima into the city it is today, this museum is highly recommended.

Shuttle bus schedule will be posted at the Shore Concierge Desk, Deck 5 and at the gangway.

VESSEL GENERAL PERMIT
