HO CHI MINH CITY, VIETNAM

The Áo Dài or the Vietnamese elegance

Vietnam has undergone many changes over the last century. However, one silhouette remains almost unchanged in the landscape of this endearing country: that of Vietnamese women adorned with the Áo Dài.

The Áo Dài is not just a garment, but a representation of Vietnam's rich cultural heritage and a symbol of elegance. Worn by women in Vietnam for centuries, the dress has evolved over time to reflect the country's changing fashion trends and social norms.

It first appeared at the end of the 18th century, as a result of the civil war that divided the country into two parts. One in the North, controlled by the Trinh family, and the other in the South by the Nguyen family. As the clothing worn in the North was too similar to that of the Chinese, Lord Nguyen asked his people to distinguish themselves from the North by wearing silk trousers under a long, wide, five-sided tunic. The ancestor of the Áo Dài was born.

Over the course of fashions, decades and political changes, its cut, rather wide at first, was adjusted to accentuate the curves of Vietnamese women, while still retaining a certain modesty. The collar disappeared and the sleeves were shortened under Diem, under the influence of Madame Nhu, the First Lady of the time, who breathed new life and modernity into the dress at the end of the 1950s, a move that was however rejected by part of the country as being too modern. When the country entered the communist era in 1975, the Áo Dài fell out of favour, as it was considered "decadent" by the ruling powers. It came back with a vengeance at the end of the 80s, never to leave the forefront of Vietnamese dressing rooms.





